- h. My best friend **was called** Tom. (*To call - Simple Past*)
- i. Her little sister **had been learning** the ABC's. (*To learn - Past Perfect Progressive*)
- j. This street **has already been closed** because of snow. (*Already/to close - Present Perfect*)
